She came to us in 2009, referred by probation as a transient, struggling with mental health, no supportive family, and living on park benches. Slowly, Joyce began to trust us and allowed us to walk alongside her on her journey to health and healing.

With time, she stabilized on medication, embraced sobriety, and started volunteering in the community. She found a church home and, in time, opened up about the deep trauma of her childhood in therapy. Over the years, we became her family, and she became ours.

We've cheered her on as she earned her driver's license, celebrated her bridal shower and wedding four years ago, and we still look forward to seeing her every Sunday night for medication support and check-ins. Today, Joyce drives her own car, lives independently, and remains active in her church and our alumni group.
