2025 Highlights and Yesterday's Successes

As we look back on 2025, we are deeply grateful for all the ways God showed up in our ministry and in the lives of the women we serve. This year was marked by transformation, growth, and tangible signs of hope:

- **Many hearts accepted Jesus**, sobriety was maintained, jobs were secured, and graduates stepped confidently into their next chapter.
- **More than 100 people joined us for Tacos & Tours**, enjoying a meal while learning about our mission. This response was so encouraging that Tacos & Tours will continue every other month in 2026.
- **We served twice as many participants as the year before**. Expanded bed space played a role, but so did the visible spiritual growth, personal success, and accomplishments of the ladies we serve, which truly became the talk of the community.
- **Two new positions were added**, including a second therapist providing weekly mental health counseling for every participant and a Program Support Specialist strengthening our employment training sites and programming.
- **Our coffee shop received a full refresh**, with new furniture, lighting, and paint made possible by generous partners who believe in the work happening here.
- **We launched a new business by taking over Dogs Dig 'Em**, a dog treat company that provides culinary training for participants. These treats are now sold in local stores such as Whitie's Pets and Save Mart, and are also available for purchase directly through our website.
