Beauty from Ashes

Beverly once had a family, a career and a future she was building alongside her husband and daughter. But when she and her husband relapsed into addiction, everything began to unravel. The grip of drugs brought domestic violence into her home and eventually, her daughter was removed from her care due to the trauma they both faced. Devastated by the loss of her family and the life she had known, Beverly was bound by addiction, believing she had nothing left to live for.

Alone, homeless and struggling with mental health, Beverly found herself trapped in a cycle of despair. She entered and exited nearly every rehabilitation program in the Central Valley, yet lasting change seemed impossible. When all other options had been exhausted, she turned to The Light House.

At The Light House, Beverly found more than recovery—she found hope, help and healing. Through the program, she gained freedom, mental clarity, emotional stability and a healing in her soul that only God could provide. Surrounded by support, safety and faith, she began the journey of rebuilding her life.



Today, Beverly is working toward reunification with her daughter and creating a brighter future for them both. She is deeply grateful for The Light House, a place she describes as a cocoon of safety where God is guiding, teaching and transforming her. With each step forward, Beverly is growing into the woman and mother God created her to be. Currently she is job searching, hoping to gain employment in Administration, she will then build her savings account to purchase a car and is looking forward to having her own unit at our transitional Bridge Apartments.

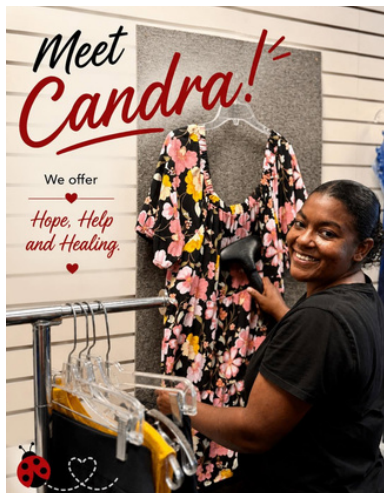
Employment Training Program

Our Employment Training Program is a comprehensive 13-week workshop designed to empower women who face barriers to employment. Available to the women we serve as well as participants from other community programs, this workshop provides the skills, knowledge and confidence needed to successfully enter or re-enter the workforce.

Participants receive training in all aspects of job readiness, including office skills, professional communication, workplace etiquette, work ethic, Dress for Success principles, resume development and interview preparation.

In addition to classroom instruction, women gain valuable hands-on experience through practical training at one of our four employment training sites.

Upon successful completion of the program, participants are connected to paid employment opportunities, helping them take the next step toward self-sustainability.
